Leap Into Literacy - 1st Grade March

You need to read (or be read to) for **15 minutes each day for 6 days a week** and do a **project** in order to qualify for Leap Into Literacy. This month your project is to be based on the **non-fiction** book you liked the best this month. A non-fiction book is a true-life book that teaches us about facts. For instance, your book could explain the facts about space, animals, a historic person, a place, etc... A non-fiction book is about something true, not make believe. March's project is to make a mobile. To make a mobile you need: a hanger, yarn, paper, scissors, tape, hole punch and crayons, colored pencils, or markers. First, draw the pictures for your mobile. Next, cut out the pictures and tape/tie them to a piece of yarn. Then, tie the yarn to the hanger. Last, put your name and the title of the book on a piece of paper, cut it out, attach it to yarn, and hang it from the hanger, too. This form and the mobile project are **due by Friday, April 1st**. (Remember to put your name on your mobile!)
