Leap Into Literacy - 2nd Grade March

You need to read (or be read to) for **20 minutes each day for 6 days a week and do a project** in order to qualify for Leap Into Literacy. This month your project is to be based on the **non-fiction** book you liked the best this month. A non-fiction book is a true-life book that teaches us about facts. For instance, your book could explain the facts about space, animals, a historic person, a place, etc... A non-fiction book is about something true, not make believe. March's project is to make a windsock. You will need a 12" x 18" piece of construction paper and 6 smaller 12" x 1.5" strips. Write the title of the book and the author's name on the 12' x 18" paper. Illustrate a picture of what you learned about. On the strips of paper, write 6 interesting facts that you learned. This form and the windsock project are **due by Friday, April 1st**. (Remember to put your name on your windsock!)
