SARB Meeting

Selective parents will be receiving letters from site level School Attendance Review Board (SARB). These letters are to update parents on their child's current number of absent days and/or tardies to school. If absents or tardies continue, a second letter with a scheduled meeting date will be set for parents to verify their child's specific attendance record and to develop a plan to lessen or eliminate tardies or absents. Students need to be in school to receive instruction, practice concepts and develop social skills.

Healthy Kids should follow the below mentioned prevention tips for staying healthy and preventing the flu or colds:

- **Wash Your Hands!!!** Numerous studies have shown that good hand washing is the simplest way to prevent the spread of colds, flu and other infectious diseases. Use warm water and soap and wash for at least 20 seconds.
- **Diet.** Maintain a well-balanced diet that includes at least 5 servings of fruits and vegetables daily. Many students don't take the time to have any food before coming to school! Even a bit of fruit or toast is better than nothing.
- **Fluids.** Drink 6-8 glasses of water each day. This helps our bodies stay well balanced.
- **Exercise.** Daily exercise, even short walks during breaks can help.
- **Dress.** Appropriate clothing allows the body to work on fighting off viruses rather than it working at staying warm.
- **Sneezing.** Try not to sneeze into your hand. Rather use a sleeve or tissue. Wash your hands frequently if you are coughing or sneezing a lot. Always cover your mouth with something when you sneeze or cough.
- **Rest.** Get plenty of rest. The average adolescent needs 8-9 hours of sleep each night. Adults could also use the same amount of rest.

Getting Involved in Your Child’s School. The National PTA offers some tips for parents to help their children. Children whose parents are active partners in their education:

- Get better grades
 - Have better attendance records
 - Have fewer problems with drugs and alcohol
 - Have a more positive attitude toward learning
- How can parents participate in their children’s education? What can they do?

1. **Be a friend of the school.** Get to know the school culture. The staff members truly make a difference in the students’ lives. Get to know them.
2. **Be aware of the school’s needs.** Very often there are resource limitations such as budget cuts. As a parent, you may be able to help find community sources to finance much needed projects, adept at applying for grants or have time you can donate to this task. You may know of unique sources that the school can use to obtain needed materials.
3. **Keep in contact with the school.** Visit the school and their website to see what is happening. There are opportunities for you to get involved.
4. **Get to know the standards.** Most states have adopted a set of benchmarks to assess students, teachers and schools. Become familiar with them.
5. **Join the PTA** or other groups that are interested in improving the effectiveness of our children’s education. The greater the membership, the greater the positive effect.

Transfer Request Forms are available at all school sites and at the District Office. Forms must be submitted directly to the Education Services Department at the District Office, Monday through Friday from 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

- In March, the Education Services Department shall conduct a lottery to determine placement on a waiting list of all transfer requests, and families will be notified by mail of their waiting list number.

NORTHWOOD ELEMENTARY, RUSKIN ELEMENTARY and SIERRAMONT MIDDLE
due to lack of available space.**

**Kindergarten and new student Intra District Transfer Request Forms for the
2017-2018 school year will be accepted from March 9, 2017 to April 28, 2017**

Families that have successfully completed the enrollment process and wish to have their child attend a school other than their resident home school may submit an “Intra District Transfer Request Form” at the time that they are submitting their completed 2017-2018 Student Enrollment packet. The Intra District Transfer Request Form will also be accepted at the District Office in the Education Services Department until April 28, with proof of a completed Student Enrollment packet.

- In May, the Education Services Department shall conduct a separate second lottery to determine placement on a waiting list of all transfer requests of Kindergarten and new students enrolling for the 2017-2018 school year, and families will be notified by mail of their waiting list number.

NORTHWOOD ELEMENTARY, RUSKIN ELEMENTARY and SIERRAMONT MIDDLE
due to lack of available space.**

Intra District Transfer Request Forms that are submitted after the deadlines of February 28 (for currently enrolled students) and April 28 (for newly enrolled students), will not be included in the lotteries and will receive the next waiting list number in the order that the Intra District Transfer Request Form was submitted. Beginning in May, families who have submitted an Intra District Transfer Request Form and have been given a waiting list number, will be notified, *only* if their transfer has been approved, based on space availability.
