Dear Parents and Guardians:

Happy November! We have already completed 52 days of school. Your children have been working hard in their classes with teachers preparing and providing rigorous units of study. Students are encouraged to think deeper and more critically, collaborate, communicate and be creative. These are the key elements of implementing the Common Core Standards. Additionally, this year, we are implementing several new programs at Laneview and in the District. Teachers in Grades K-2 are using a new Reading Benchmark Assessment System. Students in K-8 are being introduced to Writers' Workshop. Teachers across the District are using Lucy Calkins Units of Study for Writing. At Laneview, our K and first grade teachers are in Year 2 of the SEAL Program and our 2nd and 3rd grade teachers are in Year 1 implementation. This language rich program explores several units of study throughout the year.

As we enter November, Parent Teacher Conferences are right around the corner. Conferences help provide information and details on how your children are performing in the academic areas as well as his/her social and study skills. We are striving for 100% parent participation in Parent Teacher Conferences. Your partnership in your child's education is critical in achieving success. Did you know.... ***The Family-School Partnership Act is a California law that allows parents, grandparents, and guardians to take time off from work to participate in their children's school or child care activities.*** This includes Parent/Teacher Conferences.

I would like to thank all of you who came out to support our PTA's Fall Harvest Festival. It was AWESOME to see all of the children and many adults dressed up in festive costumes. TARDINESS is becoming a BIG PROBLEM at Laneview!

Since the first day of school this year....

54 students have at least 3 tardies.

Of those 54, 27 have at least 6 or more tardies. Of those 27, 8 have at least 10 or more tardies.

While some of the tardies might be within the first 5 minutes, the student is walking into class late. Think about when you are running late for work or an important appointment. You get caught in traffic or you oversleep. You have that anxious feeling about having your boss or co-workers stare at you or question you. Now think about your child walking in to class late at least once a week.

“Chronic lateness eventually takes its toll on a child's overall educational experience. According to the national initiative Attendance Works, missing just 10 percent of the school year in the early grades causes many students to struggle in elementary school, and lateness in later grades is associated with increased failure and dropout rates.” (Effects of Tardiness on Your Child's Education by Rachel Pancare, studioD)

What does this all mean? The Laneview staff wants our students to come to school on time and EVERY day ready to learn, succeed and achieve. We need your help in getting your child here on time. Parents, with students with excessive tardies, will be notified shortly.

If your child is sick and unable to attend school, please make sure to call the school office. When parents don't call, students will be marked unexcused. Too many unexcused absences and tardies will result in a truancy note.

Let's change these numbers and reduce the number of UNEXCUSED absences and tardies.

NOVEMBER 6, 2016 is Daylight Savings Time. Be sure to set your clock back 1 hour.

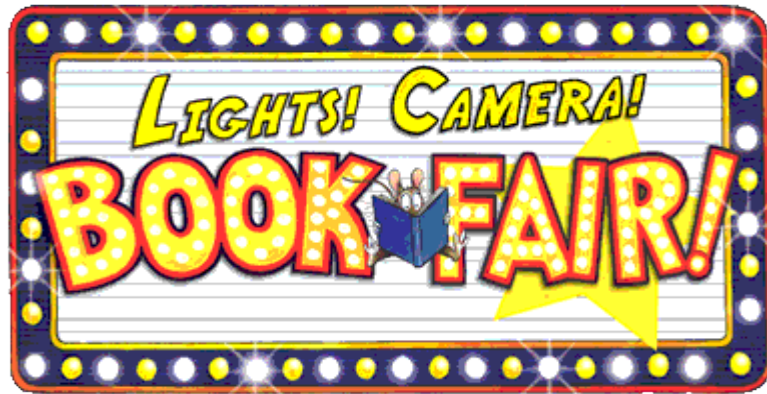
