How to Get to School on Time and still have breakfast. The morning rush can be stressful for both parents and children.

■ Discuss the problem as a family and schedule a meeting when you don't have to rush. Talk about the different things that need to happen in the morning. Make a list and post it in a place where it is visible to your child.

■ For additional motivation, develop a reward system for your child for being ready on time such as a sticker or a points chart, etc. Over the long term, children can work for rewards like a special breakfast, time to play a game with a parent or other special treats.

■ Involving your child in solving the problem can help him or her understand the importance of getting ready on time. A less stressful morning can be the start of a better day for the whole family.
