Traffic and Safety

For safety reasons, <u>no parent parking in the staff</u> <u>parking lot.</u> Please follow the basic safety rules:

- Drive slowly and legally when near the school
- Do not leave your car unattended at any time
- Let your child know where you will meet him/her after school each day
- Do not drive in staff parking lot

Student Pick-Up Information

There is only 15 minutes of supervision after dismissal. Parents, please make appropriate plans for your child's safety. All schools in the Berryessa Union School District have a minimum day every Thursday to provide time for professional development and instructional planning. Sometimes the office staff has meetings after school and there will be no one to supervise your child. Also, if your child is required to cross the street when they are being dropped off or picked up, please make them use the crosswalk.

Parents, please be polite when driving near the school, no u-turns, no jaywalking and please do not yell profanities at our staff or volunteers.

Please Don't Arrive Late to School

School Site Council

School Site Council meets once a month to monitor the school plan, review and approve budgets and assist in developing the school plan.

Administration of Prescribed Medication for Students

Two forms, A *Permit to Take Medication in School form* (Education Code 49423) and *Allergy Health Plan* must be completed by the parent/guardian and physician for all prescriptive drugs (as well as overthe-counter medication) to be dispensed at school. This form may be obtained from the school office. Medication must be sent to the <u>school office</u> in the original pharmacy container, including the student's name and the doctor's instructions. **Do not** send medication to school in a lunch box or with your child as it may be hazardous to another student if ingested.

Report Absences by Calling (408) 923-1920

Every day your child is absent from school, you <u>MUST</u> call the office to report the absence at (408) 923-1920. If you are calling the office after school hours regarding an absence, please leave the following information:

- Your child's first and last name
- Room number & teacher name
- Briefly state the reason for the absence
- State your name and relationship to the child

Please keep your child out of school if he/she has a fever of 100 degrees or higher or vomiting. Your child should be symptom free for 24 hours before returning to school without the aid of medications.

Parent Volunteers

Parents are encouraged to volunteer at school. Please contact your child's teacher if you are available. This is a powerful way of showing your child how important their schooling is to you. You must have an updated PPD (TB) test on file with the school office and if you are volunteering in the classroom, there are additional forms that <u>must</u> be completed before volunteering begins. Student Nutrition Service Information

If your child qualified for a free or reduced lunch in the 2018-2019 school year, you will need to complete a 2019-2020 application to see if they will continue to qualify. If you have not received an application, please stop by the Student Nutrition Services office as soon as possible complete one. The new SNS office is located at 951 Piedmont Rd (next to Piedmont Middle School). You may also apply online by visiting

https://www.myschoolapps.com.

Anyone may apply at any time during the school year. However, the more students at your school who qualify for free or reduced price meals at the start of the school year, the more money your school can receive from the government to spend on student programs.

You may obtain your child's current balance by (1) checking on-line at MySchoolBucks, (2) calling the school cafeteria, or (3) calling Student Nutrition Services at 408-923-1875 or 408-923-1879. You can also set-up an on-line account at http://www.myschoolbucks.com as review your child's transaction history and current balance. There is no charge to set-up the account, but there is a transaction fee for making an on-line payment.

Laneview Morning Procedures

The school playground is not open to students until the first bell. Students should arrive no earlier than 7:55am. Students, who arrive before the first bell, need to wait behind the designated lines. When the first bell rings at 7:58, 4th and 5th graders should walk to their classrooms. Students in kindergarten through 3rd grade may walk to the playground. There will be two teachers supervising the playground area when students are allowed on campus. We ask that after the first two weeks, parents and guardians, who bring students to school and choose to wait for their children to go to class, stay at the top of stairs in the designated area called "Laneview Observation Deck", while the students walk down to the playground.

The Laneview staff is asking this for several reasons.

- 1. Safety We have two teachers supervising the area. With numerous adults in the playground area, the teachers may not be able to see all of the students and any issues that arise. By only allowing teachers to supervise the playground, adults not associated with Laneview can be quickly identified.
- 2. Building Responsibility and Social Skills The Laneview staff values the whole child. Not only do we focus on the academics, we also want to build social skills and promote positive character traits in our students. We want students to be able to independently go to their lines and be responsible for their belongings. We also want to encourage them to develop social skills by being with their peers before school.
- 3. Getting to Class Efficiently When the bell rings, students on the playground will line up and walk to their classroom. Because we have several classes walking to their rooms, the staff requests that the stairways and top of the stairways remain clear so that students can get to their destination safely and efficiently.

After the bell has rung and students have entered their classrooms, we ask that all parents, guardians and caregivers exit the campus promptly unless you are going to the office for other campus business (signing in to volunteer, turning in paperwork, etc.).

The Laneview staff appreciates your cooperation in this matter. We strive to develop a positive partnership with all of you with the goal of helping our students achieve and succeed in all areas of their lives.

Be kind and considerate to our neighbors. Please, <u>do not</u>
